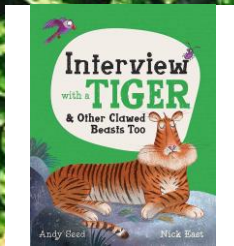

Maths

Our focus for this term is :-

- Adding and subtracting tens numbers from 2 digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting two 2 digit numbers.
- To recognise 'lots of' as multiplication and make the link between multiplication and division.
- To tell the time using o'clock, half past, quarter to/past and extending onto 5 minute intervals.
- To solve word problems.

Science

Seasonal Changes

We will be learning all about the seasons
and how they change.

We will be focusing on the impact
seasonal change has on animals and
humans and how these adapt to suit the
season.

We will investigate how the weather and
the length of day changes with the
seasons too.

Phonics and Spelling

Year 1

We will revisit and revise all previous learning in Phase 5. We will continue to practise chunking up larger words into known phonemes to aid when reading and spelling. We will begin to apply phonics knowledge when reading 'alien words' (made up words with known phonemes within them).

Year 2

Our spelling programme for Year 2 is SCODE, which is etymology enriched and phonic based. We will focus on the sound /oo/ and the many ways to spell the code – oo, ue, ew, o. We will also look at the homophones to/too/two and blue/blew.

History

What is a Monarch?

We will learn that a Monarch is a King or a Queen who is crowned in a special ceremony called a Coronation. We will learn that a coronation is a ceremony of different steps and that special objects are used.

We will discover how William the Conqueror became King of England and how he kept order. We will begin to think about how the Monarchy has changed over time.

Design Technology

Our focus for this term is Mechanisms

We will be designing and making our own cardboard moving monster toys using a series of levers, linkages and pivots to make them move. We will design two monsters (which have to be suitable for children) and use the feedback from our friends to choose one final monster to make!

Music

The Tale of Three Trees

We will be learning the music and lyrics to our production of The Tale of Three Trees this term. This will give all children the opportunity to perform on stage to an audience. The play is linked to the events from the bible where wood from trees played an important part in the life of Jesus. Contact the office for tickets !

PSHE

Relationships: What makes a good friendship?

We will be discussing how to make friends, solve problems when they occur and how to support ourselves/others emotionally. We will identify how to show respect in the way that we treat others.

Computing

We will be using Scratch Jnr to begin to understand that programs execute by following unambiguous instructions. We will learn to create, debug and make predictions about simple programs. We will learn to create simple characters that move and make sounds.

PE

We will be developing our Net and Wall Games skills. We will also be learning about the skills needed for Invasion Games. Year 2 will be participating in a cluster schools Multi skills festival this term.

RE

Judaism

We will learn about Shabbat, when this is celebrated and the traditions involved such as the sharing of the Challah bread. We will identify the importance of family blessings.
