WORLD WAR II

At the outbreak of World War II, Churchill became First Lord of the Admiralty in command of the Royal Navy. At the same time the current Prime Minister, Neville Chamberlain, wanted to appease Germany and Hitler.

Churchill warned the government that they needed to help fight Hitler or Hitler would soon take over all of Europe.

Winston Churchill was chosen to be as Prime Minister on May 10, 1940.
