Hedgehogs Class Children (Reception Year)

The EYFS profile is completed for every child in the final term of their Reception year, and has three main purposes: to inform you about your child's development, to make the transition to Year 1 smoother, and to help the Year 1 teacher plan a curriculum that will suit all of the pupils in their new class. The EYFS profile is a summary of your child's attainment at the end of Reception. It's not a test, and your child can't 'pass' or 'fail'. The profile measures your child's attainment in areas of learning known as Early Learning Goals (ELGs). In your Reception child's EYFS profile, for each of the ELGs, they'll be given one of the following gradings:

At the 'expected' level of development

At the 'emerging' level of development (in other words, they haven't quite reached it yet)

A 'good level of development' can be defined as a child reaching the 'expected' level of development at the end of their reception year, at the end of EYFS.
