Key Stage 1 Results

Key Stage 1 (end of Year 2) SATs consist of formal assessments in maths and reading that take around 3 hours in total to complete, plus informal assessments in science that take place throughout the year. SATs are just one aspect of the KS1 assessment process. If a child has additional needs and cannot access the SATs with an adult reader, the child will not participate in the SATs to support their emotional health. Twelve children in our Year 2 took part in the SATs this year. Your child's teachers takes all their work in Years 1 and 2 into consideration in order to build a full, accurate picture of how well your child is doing. The full, teacher-assessment report about your child's progress in maths, English reading, English writing and science will be sent to you by the end of the summer term. A score of 100 means your child is working at the expected standard. A score below 100 indicates that your child needs more support. A score of above 100 suggests your child is working at a higher level than expected for their age: Greater Depth. In 2024, KS1 SATs are no longer compulsory, our teachers will continue to assess pupils throughout the year instead of implementing the end of year SATs.
