Year 1 Phonics Results

The Phonics Screening Check was introduced in 2012 in primary schools in England. Most children in Year 1 take it in the summer term. Your child will be scored against a national standard, and the main result will be whether or not they fall below, within or above this standard. Since 2013 the “pass threshold” has been 32, which means children had to read at least 32 words out of 40 correctly. If your child’s score is below the standard, they will be given extra phonics help and can re-take the Check in Year 2. If a child has additional needs and cannot access the reading we will not enter them for the check, to support their own emotional well-being.
