Autumn 1 term learning journey in Foxes Class


English

Science

We will spend time becoming familiar with the story of Superworm. We will look at the different Characters, the setting, story events and begin to learn parts of the story off by heart.

We will write lists, describing sentences and draw and label characters (Y1) or create story maps (Y2). We will act out the story using puppets we have made (Y1) and write our own version of Superworm introducing a character of our own (Y2). The children will continue to work on pencil control & letter formation.

We are reading...



This half term we will be concentrating on our place value knowledge. We will be working to recognise and write our numbers correctly and to count forwards and backwards. Year One will be working with numbers within 20 and Year Two will be working with numbers within 100. We will be using the mathematical symbols <, > and = to compare different numbers.

Everyday Materials

We will become material detectives and set about discovering the different materials in our classroom and outside area. We will learn their names as well as their properties. We will be looking at different materials that are absorbent, waterproof and tough. This learning will help us to decide why items such as a toothbrush are made the way they are.

We are using the book Superworm by Julia Donaldson as our text to match our big question this half term 'What if I had super powers?' We will spend time listening to, reading aloud and

acting out the story.

Spelling

Year One

The children will be revising many of the sounds from Hedgehogs Class and will then move on to learn new representations (graphemes) for sounds (phonemes) that they already know. For example learning that ay in the word play makes the same sound as ai in rain.

Year Two

The Children will be revising many of the alternative representations (graphemes) that they learnt during the summer term in Y1. This then extends to transferring this knowledge to support their spelling as well as reading skills.
