English

We are reading...

Fiction

We will read a selection of new fairy tales including:

- The Three Pigs by David Wiesner
- The True Story of the Three Little Pigs by Jon Scieszka
- The Wolf's Story by Toby Forward.

We will recap how to punctuate speech.

We will look at the present perfect form of verbs.

Finally we will draft, edit and present a descriptive piece inspired by the stories read.

Maths

We will be focusing on multiplication and division.

We will be looking at multiplication and division facts in our times tables. We will look at related calculations and efficient multiplication.

We will be practising our times tables daily beginning with our 6 times tables.

Children are challenged with 'mastery' problem solving activities!

Spelling

Our spelling programme is SCODE, which is etymology enriched and phonic based.

This term our focus sounds are /ar/ coded ar, a and al, and /l/ coded l and ll.

We will look at code overlaps and think about how the /ar/ sound coded 'a' depends on your accent.

Art and Design – Print and Activism

We will be exploring the idea that art can be used as a way of sharing passions and interests with peers and in a community.

We will be learning about artists who are activists, and then go on to identify and voice the things that we care about as individuals.

Science

We will be learning about Living things: Classification and changing habitats. We will learn that a solid keeps its shape unless a force is applied to it, a liquid can flow freely and take on the shape of a container and a gas does not have a fixed shape and can escape from an unsealed container. We will also learn that in the water cycle, condensation is the process of water vapour cooling to form water droplets in clouds, which can result in precipitation.

RE

Our theme is : Creation/Fall

Our Key Question: What do Christians learn from the Creation story?

Religion: Christianity

History

How have children's lives changed?

We will learn that:

- the Tudor period started in 1485 when Henry VII came to the throne and ended in 1603 with the death of Elizabeth 1.
- the Victorian period started in 1837 when Victoria came to the throne and ended in 1901.
- Children tended to experience more dangerous conditions in some jobs in Victorian times than in Tudor times.
- Lord Shaftesbury helped to improve working conditions for children.

We will write a program to initiate a flashing LED panel after a button press and/or automatically initiate using the Micro:bit light sensing, as part of an eCharm. We will then create and decorate a foam pouch for the eCharm, using a template.
