Wow Words.

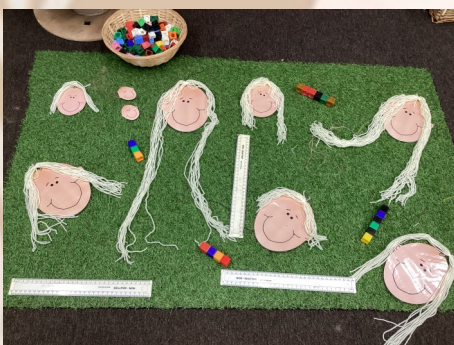
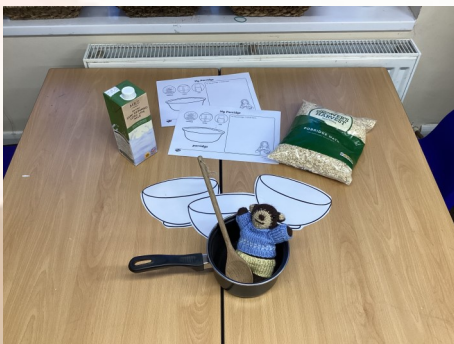
ferocious: extremely angry or violent or very unpleasant
