Art and Design — - Shadow Puppets (term 5 and 6)

To tie in with our big science question this term (How does light travel?), we are going to be investigating shadow puppets! Specifically, we will be exploring the art of paper cutting, adapting the method to make our own puppets. We will work collaboratively and take inspiration from different cultures, artists and histories.

Science

Light and Reflection

We will:

- describe the pathway of light. Working scientifically: To use evidence to form conclusions.
- describe how we see.
- Work scientifically and draw scientific diagrams.
- investigate what affects the angle of the reflected ray.
- record results as a line graph.
- explain how a periscope works.

RE-Sikhism

History

Local History Project

We will:

- Identify the type of information the Census gives about people.
- Use the census to make inferences about people from the past, providing supporting evidence for their statements.
- Make observations from the census and identify changes between periods of time.
- Identify the dangers of working in a textile mill.
- Create questions to identify the thoughts and feelings of a Victorian working child.
- Extract information from the census to recreate the lives of people who lived in a household from the local area.

PSHE-Relationships

In this topical and important unit we will be exploring our relationships with, and related to, technology and the internet. We will be learning about the safety of being a member of an online Community, as well as the positives and negatives.

We will learn about our rights and responsibilities when interacting with others online. We will also be discussing safety and communication within online gaming, and learning to recognise the importance of controlling our screen time.

Design and Technology

Doodlers

We will:

Identify simple Circuit Components (battery, bulb and switch) with a basic explanation of their function.

Explain that a series circuit is assembled in a loop to allow the electricity to flow along one path.

Develop design criteria with consideration for the target user, the purpose of their Doodler, a key function and the Doodler's form and final appearance (e.g. fun, bright, soft).
