On Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September, Squirrels Class will be visiting Stonehenge (<u>https://www.english-heritage.org.uk/visit/places/stonehenge</u>). We will explore Stonehenge and its place within the wider landscape, have an interactive tour to learn about the different stones and building techniques used and how the monument relates to the solstice alignment. We will also use role play to recreate a Bronze Age burial in the landscape, discussing replica objects based on artefacts found in the area.

A Pewsey Vale coach (<u>https://www.pewseyvalecoaches.co.uk/</u>) will pick us up from school at 9:00am and we will return by 2:45pm. Please could all children bring a packed lunch and a filled water bottle in a backpack. Please check the weather forecast as children will need a sunhat, sun cream or a raincoat depending on the weather.

The cost of the trip is £3.70 per child, which is payable through your child's school money account. Please do not hesitate to come and see us if this causes you any problems.
