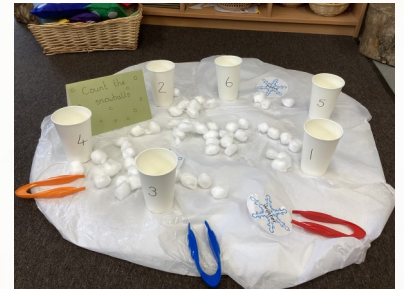
### This week
