We now need to find insurance to cover just the event.

Laura has submitted multiple insurance forms and has received some quotes back but still waiting out on some.

Potentially look at not having the bonfire, as this is what is causing the rise in insurance. Laura to potentially to go back to the insurance companies to submit new forms without the bonfire. This maybe an option for next year.
