Beliefs and Practices

This term, we will be focusing on one of our key religions for this year, Islam.

Using the theme of Beliefs and Practices', we will explore the key question, What is the best way for a Muslim to show commitment to God?'

History

Art and Design

Were the Vikings raiders/traders or something else?

In this exciting unit we will be considering this question and using historical sources and evidence to investigate who the Vikings really were and why they invaded Britain, and evaluating their impact and achievements.

We will also be studying and then Creating our own Viking Sagas.

Art- Drawing: 'T need space'

This unit focuses on understanding retro futurism, developing skills in evaluating images and Creating art through various drawing processes, including collagraph printmaking.

It emphasises the development of pupils' independent artistic skills and their ability to generate, test, and refine ideas in their sketchbooks, leading to a final piece of artwork.

We will have the opportunity to create a music score using body percussion – We will composed a group piece, which they will perform to their peers. We will also make musical instruments out of natural materials – exploring tone, pitch and rhythm. We will experiment with how to record their performance.
