On Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> February, Foxes class will be going to the Army Flying Museum, Middle Wallop, Stockbridge, Hampshire, SO20 8FB. This is an exciting opportunity to bring history to life and learn about the history of flight. We will be travelling to the museum by coach, <https://www.pewseyvalecoaches.co.uk/>. We will be leaving school at 9:50am and returning by 3.00pm (traffic permitting). Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a filled water bottle. Even though the museum is an inside venue, we recommend the children still bring a coat.

The cost of the trip is £6 per child, which is payable through your child's school money account. Please do not hesitate to come and see us if this causes you any problems.

The coach for this trip is costing £355. If you would also like to make a donation toward the cost of the coach, we would be very grateful for your support. Donations can also be made on your school money account. A donation amount has been set at £12.50 however parents/carers are welcome to adjust this amount by clicking into the small box which displays £12.50 and changing the amount. You can then add the payment to your basket by clicking on the + icon.

The children will not need to bring any spending money with them. If you would like your child to participate in the visit, please complete the online parental consent form [Foxes Class - Army Flying Museum - Fill out form](#) to give your permission for them to attend the trip, plus travel by coach by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026.
