Understanding Your Child's Report

The Progress grade indicates how well your child has developed their knowledge, skills and understanding throughout the year.

- 1 – Above Expected Progress: Your child has made more progress than would typically be expected for their year group.
- 2 – Expected Progress: Your child has made the progress expected during this academic year.
- 3 – Below Expected Progress: Your child has made less progress than expected and may require additional support to achieve their potential.

The Attainment grade indicates the standard your child is currently working at compared with the expectations for their year group.

WTS – Working Towards the Expected Standard: Your child is developing the knowledge and skills for their year group but has not yet consistently met all expected standards.

EXS – Expected Standard: Your child is meeting the expectations for their year group.

GDS – Greater Depth Standard: Your child is working beyond the expected standard and demonstrates a deeper understanding and application of their learning.

Please remember that progress and attainment measure different aspects of learning. A child may be working towards the expected standard (WTS) while still making strong progress, or they may be achieving at the expected standard (EXS) while making expected progress. Both indicators together provide a fuller picture of your child's achievements and development during the year.

When reading the report, please remember that every child develops at their own pace. The comments and assessments are intended to recognise individual achievements while also identifying next steps that will support continued learning and growth in the coming year. We are extremely proud of the hard work, resilience, and enthusiasm shown by all our pupils this year. We would also like to thank you for your ongoing support and partnership, which contributes greatly to your child's success.
